RAGGING PUNISHMENT

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the college, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the college shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding /withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the college in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Suspensions / expulsion from the hostel.
- Rustication from the college for a Period varying from 1 to 8 semesters.
- Expulsion from the college and consequent debarring from admission to any other Institution.
- Rigorous imprisonment of three years and / or a fine of up to Rs. 2,50,000/-



PUNISHMENT FOR RAGGING

Actions to be taken against students for indulging and abetting ragging:

- Ragging is strictly banned everywhere both inside outside the College premises. The defaulters will be dealt with severely as per anti-ragging rules of the institution.
- The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution will take appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.
- Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community reassurance on the potential raggers.
- Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be any one or any combination of the following:
 - Cancellation of admission
 - Suspension from attending classes
 - Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - Debarring from appearing in any test/examination
 - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
 - Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 2 semesters
 - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

The Committee Members discussed on setting up an Anti Ragging Squad involving **Boys and Girls Wardens** to prevent ragging in Hostel premises.

The Committee Members discussed on setting up an Anti Ragging Squad involving **Bus Incharges** to prevent ragging in College Buses.

Roles and Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Squad

The Committee discussed about Roles and Responsibilities of Anti Ragging Squad:

- Anti ragging squad members have to monitor the student activities in the common places like sports ground, canteen, library during working hours by on rotational basis.
- Additional duty of checking hostels, canteen and student gathering common places during the night on rotational basis is allotted to Boys and Girls Hostel Wardens.
- Bus Incharges have to monitor the student activities in the bus both in the morning and evening.

The Anti Ragging Committee suggested for having a different the break and lunch time of first year students and higher semester students.

Morning break for First year students - 10.45 – 11.00 am

Morning break for Higher semester students - 10.00 – 10.15 am

Lunch for First year students - 12.30 – 01.15 pm

Lunch for Higher semester students - 11.45 – 12.30 pm

Also separate mess halls have to be allotted for first year students in the hostel to avoid any incident of ragging.

The committee suggested for allotting rooms in a separate floor (1st floor) for first year students in the hostel.

It was decided to monitor the student activities for any form of ragging in the campus through the Anti Ragging squad visits and patrolling around the campus.

It was suggested that the Hostel wardens should go on rounds during night to avoid any incident of ragging.

The committee has suggested that HoDs should make surprise visit to the hostel in the evening on alternate days.

- HoD-Civil on Mondays
- HoD-ECE on Wednesdays
- HoD-Mech on Fridays

One of the anti-ragging committee members periodically should stay in hostel for a day without and any prior notice and monitor the hostel premises.


















The following points are discussed during the Anti-Ragging Committee Meeting held on

1. The Committee Members were informed about the guidelines of UGC and AICTE in prevention of ragging and the details of consequences of ragging.
2. It is decided to make the students aware of all these norms related to ragging and it have to be clearly mentioned in the Students handbook. It also has to carry the format of the affidavit to be submitted by the student as well as by the parent/guardian against any activity that amounts to ragging.
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4. The Committee Members discussed on setting up an Anti Ragging Squad involving Boys and Girls Wardens to prevent ragging in Hostel premises.
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 - Additional duty of checking hostels, canteen and student gathering common places during the night on rotational basis is allotted to Boys and Girls Hostel Wardens.
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7. The Anti Ragging Committee suggested for having a different the break and lunch time of first year students and higher semester students.
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Morning break for Higher semester students - 10.00 – 10.15 am
Lunch for First year students - 12.30 – 01.15 pm
Lunch for Higher semester students - 11.45 – 12.30 pm
8. Also separate mess halls have to be allotted for first year students in the hostel to avoid any incident of ragging.
9. The committee suggested for allotting rooms in a separate floor (1st floor) for first year students in the hostel.

10. It was decided to monitor the student activities for any form of ragging in the campus through the Anti Ragging squad visits and patrolling around the campus.
11. It was suggested that the Hostel wardens should go on rounds during night to avoid any incident of ragging.
12. The anti ragging committee members should collect feedback from the first year students through interaction with them and build a better relationship with the students.
13. One of the anti-ragging committee members periodically should stay in hostel for a day without and any prior notice and monitor the hostel premises.

























Why should I & How can I use On Line affidavits ?

1. It is mandatory for every student and his/her parents to submit an anti ragging affidavit at the time of first admission and there after each year at the time of annual registration. These are UGC's regulations.
2. It is the order of the Hon. Supreme Court that contact details of students must be collected from these affidavits and stored electronically at a central location.
3. Uptil now each college collected such information. But it was not stored in any central location. But this year the Ragging Prevention Program developed an ON LINE procedure for downloading anti ragging affidavits. As a result college authorities do not have to collect information separately and compile it. It will save a lot of their time and energy.



Dear Madam/Sir,

In order to prevent ragging UGC has framed regulation on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions. These regulations are mandatory and all institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism as per provisions in the above regulations and ensure its strict compliance. The UGC has also taken several proactive steps including effective launch of Media Campaign for preventing ragging. Films in ragging are also uploaded on UGC website for use by higher education institutions.


As a step further, UGC has decided that from this year **Anti Ragging Day would be observed on 12th August followed by Anti Ragging Week from 12th August to 18th August.** This initiative is one of the tools of the Commission in increasing awareness against ragging. It is further desired to adopt the following activities during the celebration of Anti Ragging Day/Week:

- Introduction/Orientation programme on Anti Ragging.
- Conduct various competitions such as slogan & essay writing, poster making, and logo designing on Anti Ragging and distribute certificates/prizes to encourage the students/faculty/non-teaching staff to promote Anti Ragging.
- Events like Anti-Ragging workshops, seminars and other creative avenues to spread the idea.
- TVCs, short films and documentary movies may be shown to students and faculty. (Available on UGC websites i.e. www.ugc.ac.in & www.antiragging.in)

The Universities and Colleges are requested to share the details of the weeklong activities amongst students, faculty and other stakeholders with a request for their active participation. Details of celebration/participation activities may please be shared on the website i.e. www.antiragging.in. You are also requested to instruct your affiliated colleges/institutions to follow the suit.

As you are aware, in pursuance to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and in compliance of All India Council for Technical Education (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institution, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education) Regulations 2009, it is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/Guardian to submit an online undertaking each academic year at either of the two designated web sites, namely, www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org.

As part of UGC's initiative toward reduction of compliance burden of its stakeholders, UGC has revised the procedure for students to file online Anti Ragging Affidavit (A copy of the revised procedure is enclosed).

The revised procedure is as follows:

Step 1: A student will submit his/her details on the same web sites (www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org) as before; read and confirm that he/she and his/her parents/Guardians have read and understood the AICTE regulations on curbing the menace of ragging. He / She will confirm & agree that he/she will not engage in ragging in any form. (**Step 1 is the same like before**).

Step 2: The student will receive an e-mail with his/her registration number and a web link. The student will forward the link to the e-mail of the Nodal Officer in his/her university/college. (**please note that the student will not receive pdf affidavits and he/she is not required to print & sign it as used to be the case earlier**).

Step 3: The Nodal Officer in the University/College can click on the link of any forwarded e-mails that he/she will received from any student of his/her college to get the list of those students who have submitted Anti Ragging Affidavits/Undertakings in his/her college. The list will be updated every 24 hours.

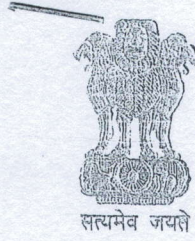
