2022: The 2022 job fair had 41 companies participating and attracted 7,134 participants. This event led to 1,144 job offers, reflecting a steady demand for employment opportunities and the effectiveness of the job fair format. The fair's success illustrated the ongoing need for direct engagement between employers and job seekers, particularly in a recovering economy.

2023: In 2023, 46 companies participated in the job fair, which had 5,230 participants and resulted in 1,176 job offers. It also highlighted PERI's commitment to fostering strong relationships with industries, ensuring that students and job seekers had access to the best opportunities available.

2024: The most recent job fair in 2024 saw 6,254 participants and 1490 job offers from 32 companies. This fair reinforced the importance of personal interactions in the hiring process, which can often lead to more meaningful employment relationships.

The PERI Job Fairs have seen a steady increase in the offer rate compared to the number of candidates shortlisted for interviews over the years. PERI Job Fair 2014
